The Marshall County Courthouse in Guntersville will open on May 18<sup>th</sup> at 8 am. Chairman Hutcheson has put security measures in place which will require that ALL persons entering the building MUST wear a mask, have temperature checked at security entrance and practice social distancing. Anyone whose temperature is above 100.4 will be turned away and recommended to see a physician.

Persons needing assistance in the offices of Probate, Revenue, Board of Registrars and the Court System MUST enter through the front door entrance on Gunter Avenue.

Persons needing the County Agent, PALS, Veteran's Affairs or Neena's Courthouse Grill MUST enter through the Ground floor entrance on Taylor Street.
