Applicant affirmatively states and agrees:

1. That the information provided here in is true and accurate to the best of his knowledge.
2. To route trucks around low weight bridges on county roads and notify the county engineer immediately if bridge damage is noticed.
3. To notify the county engineer immediately should potholes or pavement distress be present or begin to form on the county roadway.

4. To monitor conditions and take steps to minimize damage to the roadway and mud on the highway during wet weather.
5. To post signs to warn of trucks entering the highway and mud on the highway as needed.
6. To not use the right-of-way for loading timber, or parking equipment or trucks.
7. To remove any logging debris from right-of-ways.
8. That, the Contractor may, at his discretion, document the current conditions of all county roadways in the timber harvesting area to be used by the Contractor. This documentation shall be in the form of photographs or video footage. Evidence of damaged roadways may be submitted with the notification form in order to document this damage with the county prior to harvesting.
9. That failure to comply with terms and conditions herein prior to beginning operations may result in a bonding requirement in an amount to be determined by the Marshall County Commission.
10. That, if the timber owner fails to comply with the notice requirements set out in the Marshall County Logging Notice Ordinance may be fined five hundred dollars (\$500) per day for each day that he or she is in violation of the provisions of the Ordinance.
11. That the person signing this application is a duly appointed representative of the Timber Owner and is authorized by the Timber Owner to submit this Notification.
