A motion was made by Commissioner Shumate, duly seconded by Commissioner Baker, and all members voting affirmatively and so carried to approve the consent agenda presented as read by Chairman Hutcheson. The consent agenda includes the minutes from the February 8, 2023 meeting, and the claims docket for February 7, 2023 - February 20, 2023 for \$724,183.95.

MCPALS - ANNOUNCE WHITE GOODS PICKUP AND DUMPSTERS FOR DISTRICTS 1,3 & 4 ON FEBRUARY 27, 2023 (DISTRICTS 3 &4 FREE, DISTRICT 1 PAYS)

<u>ENGINEERING – APPROVE BID AWARD FOR BID 51-22 FOR ONE (1) OR MORE 24' LONG HYBRID DUMP TRAILER(S)</u>
